We have processed your claim in accordance with the Amended and Restated Settlement Agreement for the Fortis settlement dated 13 April 2018, as such was approved by the Amsterdam Court of Appeal (the "Settlement Agreement"). Capitalised terms not otherwise defined in this letter have the meaning ascribed to them in the Settlement Agreement which can be found at www.forsettlement.com.

After review of your claim, we have determined that, your claimed holdings of Fortis Shares result in a **Provisional Claim Amount** under the terms of the Settlement Agreement.

Your Provisional Claim Amount, as calculated according to the Settlement Distribution Plan, is € 950.00. Below is a breakdown of the calculation resulting in your Provisional Claim Amount.

Because you submitted a valid and approved Claim Form on or before 31 December 2018, **you are eligible for an Early Distribution Amount of € 665.00**, i.e. **70**% of your Provisional Claim Amount. This amount will not be reclaimed regardless of what your Final Claim Amount will be.

Please be advised that your Provisional Claim Amount of € 950.00 is subject to potential dilution or increase. If, once all claims have been processed, it turns out that compensation has been claimed for more Fortis Shares than expected, the amount of compensation per Fortis Share may be proportionately reduced in accordance with the Settlement Distribution Plan outlined in the Settlement Agreement. Conversely, if it turns out that compensation has been claimed for fewer Fortis Shares than expected, the amount of compensation per Fortis Share could increase in accordance with the Settlement Distribution Plan outlined in the Settlement Agreement. That means that your Provisional Claim Amount is not necessarily a representation of your Final Claim Amount, which cannot be finally determined until all claims processing is complete.
